Brief description of role:

A+ has acquired 80 acres of farmland in Oxfordshire to create our first '[AdventureBase](#)'.

This Internship combines the opportunity to develop this wonderful site - improving biodiversity and helping visitors grow in understanding and appreciation of the Natural world; with acquisition of a range of qualifications to grow your confidence and competence in the outdoors.

Conservation role: help develop improved landscaping for this Christian Outdoor Education & Adventure Youthwork centre on this (currently intensely farmed monoculture) site.

Priorities:

Develop and maintain a site which reflects the love of the Creator God through the beauty of His Creation as we implement our detailed site management plan.

Provide a warm welcome to all, and foster greater understanding of ecology, the natural world. & Creation Care

Work with local volunteers to improve the site, planting native species & improving existing flora (woodland management, hedge-laying weekends etc)

Help develop material for field studies as we share these principals with schools and youth groups

Adventure Leadership includes training as leaders in activities such as canoe/kayak, climbing, mountain biking, expeditions &/or archery.

This Internship is hosted by A+, in association with A Rocha UK.

[A+ interns](#) participate in a wider training programme which also includes a Discipleship & Spiritual Development . The year is managed by our dedicated A+ Training Coordinator.
